Passports & Visa Requirements

- **Passport:** Visitors must have a valid passport with at least six months' validity.
 - **Visa:** Check the UK Government website for visa requirements. Many travelers from the US, EU, Canada, and Australia can enter visa-free for up to six months.
 - **UK Border Control:** Be prepared to show proof of accommodation and return ticket if requested.
 - **Currency & Payments:** The currency is the British Pound (GBP). Credit and debit cards are widely accepted, and contactless payments are popular.
